- i. Post-graduate Diploma in **Disability Studies and Management**
- ii. Post-graduate Diploma in **Communication Therapy**

PROGRAMME OBJECTIVE

The programme is aimed at availing graduates the opportunities to develop a strong interdisciplinary foundation in social, legal and political concept of disability and communication disorders. It is also a vital tool in providing services in learning opportunities for agencies, service providers, Governmental and Non-Governmental Organizations. The programme is aimed at maximizing the potential abilities in special education and to build up the manpower capacity in training personnel with basic academic requirements in Education in Nigeria and beyond.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Admission into the programme is open to first degree holders in any discipline. No Aptitude Test or Interview is required.

MODE OF STUDY AND PROGRAMME DURATION

The Programme is Full Time and for a duration of 12 calendar months. During the period, the students shall be exposed to practical Case History on children with disabilities and communication disorder **as field work**.

AWARD OF DEGREE

Successful students at the end of the programme shall be awarded a Post-Graduate Diploma in their respective area of specialization.
