OPENING PRAYER

The opening prayer was said by the Dean, Faculty of Pharmaceutical Sciences, Professor Jonah Sydney Aprioku. The meeting commenced at 2:00 p.m.

OPENING REMARKS

The Vice-Chancellor and Chairman, Professor Owunari A. Georgewill welcomed all stakeholders to the meeting. He re-emphasized that University Stakeholders comprises of staff, students, alumni, university-based unions, parents and guardians, members of the host communities amongst others. He noted that Universities are universal and to be recognized internationally, must fulfil basic international accreditation requirements and as such the University of Port Harcourt is undergoing an International Institutional Accreditation by QAA Global for which policy documents in the University must demonstrate the involvement and input of stakeholders.

The Vice-Chancellor noted that University policies must be well documented and articulated as upload of such documents on the University website is a key requirement for the accreditation. Hence, he noted this stakeholder engagement is targeted at enriching existing policy documents and where necessary recommend new policy documents for an effective University administration.
