NATIONAL INNOVATION DIPLOMA (NID) PROGRAMS

The NID program runs for 2 years on a full- time basis, or for a maximum of 5 years on a part-time basis. During this period, the candidates acquire Relevant, Innovative, Industry-Specific Technical knowledge, Skills, Attitudes and Experiences, based on a minimum of 70% Practical Learning Content.

Admission Requirements

Admission to most of the programs is based on demonstration of skill and talent. Every candidate for admission is required to fill and submit an application form accompanied with a sample of creative work or demonstrable talent work. The applicant will undergo screening and ranking tests as well as oral interviews.

B. Entry Qualifications For Six Months Professional Programs:

C. Entry Qualifications For One Month Capacity Building Programs:

A participant must be 18 years and above to be eligible for consideration. Must provide at least a Certificate/ Testimonial/Transcript from previous Educational Institution(s).
